MATCH THE VERBS WITH THE PICTURES. ADD -S OR -(IES).

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We add **-ES** to the 3<sup>rd</sup> person singular when:

a verb ends in **-SS, -CH, -SH, -X** or **-O**

a verb ends in a **consonant +Y** (in this case we change the **-y** to **-i** and then add **-es**)
